PRESBYTERY OF SAN FRANCISCO EAST REGION MEETING

Minutes of February 11, 2020

These Minutes document the East Region meeting, held at Irvington Presbyterian Church in Fremont during the February 11, 2020 Presbytery meeting.

Pastor Barbara Barkley opened the meeting with prayer at 4:15 pm; and then asked all attendees to introduce themselves and identify their favorite ice cream flavor.

Pastor Barbara led a small group exercise by asking each participant to identify: a) what scripture is your ministry based on, and b) is there a specific scripture that you struggle with, and why?

QUORUM: A quorum was present because 23 Presbyters from 11 East Region churches attended this meeting. For a quorum, 10 of the 14 churches in the East Region must be represented. A list of attendees is included at the end of these Minutes.

<u>MEETING ACCOMPLISHMENTS</u>: To continue the East Region's housing-related mission work, funded by grants through the Presbytery's Regional Missional Partnerships:

- 1. Pastor Lauren Gully, a member of the East Region's Partnership Management Team, reminded all present of the responsibility we have to make wise decisions about getting the missional funds Presbytery has made available to our region out to help people. She urged our churches to be creative and identify housing-related mission projects, and to prepare grant funding proposals for the team to review. Copies of the criteria, application form, and management process that our region previously adopted were made available:
- 2. Elder Jon Myers, also a member of the Partnership Management Team, summarized the first two grant-funded projects: the January-April 2019 Parking Lot Program at Community Presbyterian Church of Pittsburg, funded for \$32,000; and Humanity Way's December 2019 project to provide housing and homeless prevention services to a minimum of 50 homeless or at-risk individuals and families, funded for \$200,795 last October;
- 3. Elder Jon informed East Region representatives that a third grant request, submitted by 2MIPeople Ministries, was approved by the East Region's Partnership Management Team earlier this month. The \$152,720 grant was awarded to 2MIPeople Ministries to develop and provide training to churches and community groups on how to support people with mental health issues as they seek to make the transition from homelessness to housing, as well as to support people with mental health diagnoses at risk of losing their housing due to issues related to symptom exacerbation and disengagement from mental health service providers. 2MIPeople Ministries Executive Director Rev. Dr. Johanna Wagner and Dr. Michael Coyle, Director of Education and Outreach, were invited to summarize their proposal and answer questions from attendees. They founded 2MIPeople Ministries in St. Louis before Pastor Johanna was called as Pastor at First Presbyterian Church of Concord last year; and
- 4. The East Region representatives were informed that the Partnership Management Team has received a fourth grant request, which they have just begun to review.

FOLLOW UP ACTION ITEMS:

Minutes of this meeting will be submitted to the Presbytery Office so they can be posted on the Presbytery's webpage.

The Partnership Management Team will proceed to negotiate a grant agreement with 2MIPeople Ministries, the recipient of the new grant, conferring with Presbytery's Finance & Property Oversight Committee Resource Manager before finalizing the agreement.
