



## **MFT/PCC/MSW Part-time Trainee (non-licensed), Berkeley Christian Counselors**

### **Position Overview**

As a member of the Berkeley Christian Counselors (BCC) Clinical team, each MFT/PCC/MSW Trainee provides excellent direct client clinical service in accordance with the California Board of Behavioral Science (BBS) and to accomplish the mission of the counseling center and the church. Non-Licensed Clinicians at BCC abide by the policies and procedures of the clinic and support the Executive Director and Clinical Director to achieve the objectives and efficient operation of BCC.

### **Key Responsibilities**

#### **Clinical Excellence**

- Overall (under the supervision of the BCC Clinical Supervisors)
  - Implement integrity, high ethical standards and counseling competence in clinical practice
  - Foster an environment of teaming and collaboration amongst the counselors
  - Protect the welfare of clients by application of appropriate practices
  - Comply with BCC policies and procedures in keeping with BBS guidelines in all areas of clinical practice and including but not limited to: record keeping, client confidentiality, issues of diversity, ethical and legal concerns, mandated reporting laws and the like.
  - Process intakes and collaborate with intake team
  
- Training (in partnership with and under the direction of the Clinical Supervision Team, Clinical Director, and the Executive Director)
  - Increase professional competencies by acquiring, improving, and refining the skills required by your role and function through regular continuing education and training
  - Contribute to BCC's inventory of continuing education resources and assets
  - Extend training to BCC counselors, when appropriate, based on your own professional area(s) of expertise

#### **Theological Integration**

- Actively work to integrate Christian faith and psychological principles and practices
- Provide spiritual support and nurturing of clients and fellow counselors as part of the BCC team

#### **General**

- **Publicity and Marketing**
  - MFT/PCC/MSW Trainees must engage in BCC outreach (3 hours minimally on a quarterly basis) to bring in new clients (i.e. represent BCC at a mental health fair, give a presentation at a local church, manage the BCC Facebook page)
    - Develop ongoing and positive awareness of BCC among other churches, counselors, clinics, medical centers, etc.
- Other duties as assigned by Executive Director, Clinical Director, or Clinical Supervisor

**Reports to:** Clinical Supervisors, Clinical Director and Executive Director, Berkeley Christian Counselors

**Schedule:** **Attendance and participation in weekly group supervision is expected (currently Tuesday afternoons). Additionally, individual supervision is extended over and above group supervision (not in lieu of). Certain clinic-wide trainings are also required (usually on Thursday afternoons).**

**Compensation:** **MFT/PCC/MSW Trainees are volunteers and receive no compensation for their clinical services while at the trainee level. However, non-licensed clinicians receive free group and individual supervision, counseling space, workspace usage, ongoing publicity and client referrals from BCC and FPCB, and administrative support from BCC (including scheduling and billing as needed).**
