She teaches relational wisdom and peacemaking in seminars and workshops throughout the United States. Kristen also trains others to serve as coaches and mediators using a biblical peacemaking model.

Kristen recently retired from her private secular mediation practice and her role on the mediation panel for the U.S. District Court's Alternative Dispute Resolution program in San Francisco. She currently serves as a Board member for Vital Church Ministry, a non-profit organization that serves churches and church denominations that are undergoing leadership transitions. Vital Church provides diagnostic services and intentional interim pastors to help churches navigate change and revitalize ministry.

Class Description: This class will introduce and amplify two foundational courses developed by Ken Sande of Relational Wisdom 360: "Discovering Relational Wisdom" and "Relational Peacemaking". The RW360 website defines these skill sets as follows: "Relational Wisdom, in essence, is the desire and ability to obey Jesus' timeless command, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart... and love your neighbor as yourself" (Matt. 22:37-39). To put it another way, relational wisdom ("RW") is a theological paradigm that combines the gospel, the wisdom-principles of scripture and our God-given capacity for 'emotional intelligence" into a discipleship paradigm for developing skills that strengthen relationships and prevent conflict. Relational Peacemaking is a systematic theology for resolving conflict and reconciling people. This training is based on Ken Sande's book, The Peacemaker, which has sold over 500,000 copies in 20 languages and is organized under four key principles (the "4 G's"): Glorify God, Get the Log Our of Your Own Eye, Gently Restore and Go and Be Reconciled."

This seminar will incorporate instructional teaching, as well as movie video clips to illustrate the principles and skills introduced. There will be plenty of class discussion, as well as a hands-on workshop on Saturday to practice applying the principles and skills you'll be learning. *Please see the next page for important readings prior to class*.
