The Nominating Committee/Committee of Representation is seeking applications for the Presbytery's Youth Adult Advisory Delegate to the next meeting of the General Assembly, which will be held June 25 – July 4, 2024 in Salt Lake City, UT. The Youth Adult Advisory Delegate (YAAD) participates in meaningful ways in the work and deliberations of the Assembly. Although the YAAD does not have a vote in the final floor decisions of the Assembly, the YAAD does have voice and vote in the committee to which the YAAD is assigned. Being a YAAD provides the youth adult with a unique opportunity to take part in the work and ministry of the broader church. As is the case with regular commissioners to the Assembly, the Presbytery covers the cost for the Youth Adult Advisory Delegate's participation (travel, room and board).

Your church is invited to submit an application from one of your youth. He or she needs to be:

- a member of your church who is active in the life and work of your congregation
- at least 17 years of age and no older than 23 years of age as of 6/25/24 (the day the Assembly convenes)
- a person who you believe will both benefit from and contribute to the work of the General Assembly.
