

NAVIGATING TO TRI-VALLEY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

- ❖ There is parking available on-site.
- ❖ We highly recommend you **carpool** with others as available parking spots can become limited.
- ❖ The nearest BART station to the church is a 15 mile walk.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DIRECTIONS

If you're taking **BART** to Tri-Valley Presbyterian Church, the easiest stop is usually **West Dublin/Pleasanton Station**, which is slightly closer to the church than the Dublin/Pleasanton terminus. Both stations are served by BART and connect to local Wheels buses, rideshare, or a short drive. ([BART](#))

Here are typical trips from around the Bay:

Origin	BART trip	Approx. travel time
San Francisco	Any East Bay train to Bay Fair (or another transfer point as directed), then transfer to the Dublin/Pleasanton line	60–75 min
Oakland (12th St., 19th St.)	Direct Dublin/Pleasanton train	35–45 min
Berkeley	Train toward the East Bay, transfer if needed to the Dublin/Pleasanton line	45–60 min
Walnut Creek	Train to MacArthur or another transfer station, then Dublin/Pleasanton line	45–60 min
South Bay	BART from Berryessa (or connect via VTA), then transfer as needed	60–90 min

From **West Dublin/Pleasanton Station** to the church:

- 🚗 Rideshare: about **5–8 minutes**
- 🚌 **Wheels** local bus: approximately **10–20 minutes**, depending on the route and schedule.
- 🚶 Walking: about **30–40 minutes** (roughly 1.5 miles). ([BART](#))
